INTERNSHIP OVERVIEW

Below are learning experiences available for interns at Life-Line Resources:

- ***Skill Development Services***

Interns assist Remedial Service Counselors in providing services and activities consist of aiding individuals in building their self esteem, character, decision making skills and communication skills.

- ***Tracking and Monitoring***

Interns assist the Counseling Services Department in monitoring the clients' behaviors in the home and the community

- ***Life-Line Recovery***

Interns assist the Substance Abuse Team in providing assistance to adolescents in their journey to learn healthy and new ways of managing their lives without alcohol and drugs. This includes activities that address the symptoms and causes of substance abuse and addiction.

- **ADMINISTRATIVE & OTHER OPPORTUNITIES**

Interns at Life-Line Resources observe counselors giving presentations. They set up displays and represent Life-Line Resources at conferences, community and church outreach events, and other events as needed. Interns are provided with a thorough orientation and have access to resource materials, etc. to aid them in their presentations. Interns are trained to answer phones and may be called upon to do special projects.

Internships are not paid positions. We ask for one semester commitment working at least two days a week.
